About Faculty of Social Work:

Faculty of Social Work, The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda is one of the pioneering institutes in Social Work Education of the country. Being the 3rd in chronological order of establishment, the Faculty has catered to the needs of its stakeholders by offering various programmes. Making a modest beginning as the Baroda College of Social Work in 1949, it is the only institute in the country to be elevated at a Faculty level in 1951. The Faculty which began by offering a Masters program in Social Work slowly expanded its wings to imparting Diploma Program in Industrial Relations and Personnel Management in 1976, Master of Human Resource Management in 1999, Diploma in Human Resource Management in 2003, Bachelor of Social Work in 2013 and very recently introduced PG Diploma in Corporate Social Responsibility in 2014. This year the Faculty has been ranked 5th in the country in the survey conducted by Outlook Magazine for the ranking of Professional Colleges imparting Social Work Education in the Country.

Five Year Integrated Master Program (Dual Degree) in Social Work:

The National Education Policy 2020 – the first education policy of 21st century proposes the revision and revamping of all aspects of the education structure, including its regulation and governance, to create a new system that is aligned with the aspirational goals of 21st century, including Sustainable Development Goals, while building upon India's traditions and value systems.

The policy envisages broad based, multi-disciplinary, holistic Under Graduate education with flexible curricula, creative combinations of subjects, integration of vocational education and multiple entry and exit points with appropriate certification. UG education can be of 3 or 4 years with multiple exit options and appropriate certification within this period

With an experience of running market evolved courses with ease and finesse, the Faculty of Social Work introduces a new Integrated Program - ***Bachelor and Master of Social Work (BMSW)*** for the many aspiring youth who wish to make their career in the field of Social Work.

Objectives of the Integrated Program:

1. To prepare professional social workers who can be leaders in their field of specialization with knowledge and advanced skills to enhance social functioning and facilitate positive social change – locally, nationally, globally.
2. To meet the growing demand of professionally trained social workers across the country to work at micro, mezzo and macro levels.
3. To help the cadre of professional social workers develop required attitude and temperament in critically understanding and responding to peoples' issues, social development and empowerment process.

Nature of the Programme: Higher Payment Programme

Course Duration: Five Years

Eligibility Criteria:

- Admission will be based on written test
- The Candidates who have passed SSC and HSC or Equivalent Board Examination with Minimum 45% (5% Relaxation to SC/ ST Students) with English as a Subject are eligible for BSW and MSW Programme.
- The candidates belonging to SC and ST, Nomadic Tribes and Denotified Tribes, SEBC, Economically Backward Class and Physically Handicapped shall be reserved as per Government Rules.

Registration Fee: Rs.600/-

Intake : 80

Mode of Admission: Admission Test

Fees Structure: For Boys & Girls: Rs.60, 000 per annum+ Exam fee as per University Norms (subject to revision)

Exit Norms of the Programme:

1. A Candidate will be awarded UG certificate in Social Work on the completion of First two semesters of the study (One Year)
2. A Candidate will be awarded UG Diploma in Social Work after completion of foursemesters of the study (First Two Years of Study)
3. A Candidate will be awarded Bachelor degree in Social Work on the completion of six semesters of the study (Three Years)
4. A Candidate will be awarded Master degree in Social Work named Five years Integrated Masters in Social Work Programme on the completion of Ten semesters of the study (Five Years)
