About Faculty of Social Work:

Faculty of Social Work, The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda is one of the pioneering institutes in Social Work Education of the country. Being the 3rd in chronological order of establishment, the Faculty has catered to the needs of its stakeholders by offering various programmes. Making a modest beginning as the Baroda College of Social Work in 1949, it is the only institute in the country to be elevated at a Faculty level in 1951. The Faculty which began by offering a Masters program in Social Work slowly expanded its wings to imparting Diploma Program in Industrial Relations and Personnel Management in 1976, Master of Human Resource Management in 1999, P.G. Diploma in Human Resource Management in 2003, Bachelor of Social Work in 2013, and P.G. Diploma in Corporate Social Responsibility in 2014. The Faculty has been ranked 5th in the country in the survey conducted by Outlook Magazine for the ranking of Professional Colleges imparting Social Work Education in the Country in 2019.

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Eligibility Criteria:

Candidates who have passed qualifying Bachelor Degree Examination with minimum

10+2+3 years of study or 10+2+4 years of study in case of Technology Engineering branches

or its equivalent in any discipline as a regular students from recognized university with at

least in aggregate 50 percent marks and 45 percent marks in case of SC/ST candidates or an

equivalent grade are eligible for applying for admission to the M.S.W Programme. The

percentage aggregate of marks is to be calculated as per the practice followed by the

concerned University/ Institution. Those who are in the final year and who expect to

complete all the requirements of graduation successfully can also apply.

Candidate should have passed S.S.C and H.S.C. with English as one of the subjects.

a) Those who have passed graduation in other medium of instruction than English should

have English as one of the subjects at graduation.

b) Those who have English as medium of instruction at Graduate level and do not have

English as a subject are also eligible to apply.

Seats for SC and ST candidates, Nomadic Tribes and Denotified Tribes and SEBC,

Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) shall be reserved as per Government rules.

Candidates coming from Universities other than The Maharaja Sayajirao University of

Baroda will be finally accepted for admission only after obtaining Eligibility certificate from

The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda. Candidates coming from Universities other

than The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda will be finally accepted for admission

only after obtaining Eligibility certificate from The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda.

Admissions will be based on the candidate's performance in the admission test.

Note: No student at this University can register simultaneously for more than one Degree or full

time Diploma.
