Applications are invited from the students who are registered for Ph. D in the Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda for fifteen (15) Research Scholarships of the value of Rs.6000/- per month each, tenable for a period of 3 years. The Annual Contingent Grant will be of Rs.5000/- for the all Faculties towards expenses on Apparatus; Chemical Equipments; Books, Journals, Photo-Stat Copies, Microfilms, Typing (including Thesis), stationery, Postage, Field work /Travel etc.

The prescribed application form are available from the Office of the Registrar, (ADM), The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda on payment of Rs.50/-from 25th July 2022. Application form should be duly completed, forwarded through the Dean and Head, so as to reach to the Registrar, The Maharaja Sayajirao of Baroda, Vadodara-390002, latest by 20th August 2022.

Short notes describing the period and specific Research Project under taken should be variably accompany the application together with the opinion of the Guiding Teacher and the Head of the Department.

Deans of the Faculties/Principals and Heads of the Institutions are requested to send applications of eligible candidates, Department wise/Subject wise in preference to Merit under a covering letter in one lot, latest 20th August 2022.

They are also requested to advise the applicants concerned to write maximum marks obtained and percentage of Marks/final grade and equivalent percentage of marks in the application and to attach true copies of mark sheets, of degree and Post-graduate degree examinations passed by them and copy of Ph.D. Registration Certificate without fail.

AMENDED ORDINANCE – 221
(APPROVED VIDE S.R. No. 41 Dated 25-11-2011)

O.221:-

Research Scholarship may be awarded by the Syndicate, subject to the budget provision for the purpose, to deserving students for pursuing PH.D degree in the University as follows:

- I. The awards always will be made by the Syndicate on the recommendation of a committee appointed by the Vice-Chancellor for this purpose. The decision of the Syndicate will be final.
- II. Every year fifteen(15) research scholarships of the value of Rs.6000/- per month, each tenable for a period of 3 years with an annual contingent grant of Rs. 5000/- for the Faculties of the M.S. University of Baroda towards the expenses on apparatus, chemicals, equipments, books, journals, Photostat copies, micro films, typing(including thesis), stationery, postage field work/travel etc. may be awarded
- III. Applications for these scholarships in the prescribed form will be sent to the Registrar by 15th August every year through the Head of the Department and the Dean of the Faculty concerned.
- IV. Candidates having good academic record with at least 50% marks at Bachelor's and 55% marks at Master's degree will be eligible for these scholarships.
- V. The award of these scholarships will be limited only to students who have registered themselves for PH.D in this University.
- VI. A candidate who is in receipt of any emoluments, scholarships or stipend from any other source shall not be considered for the award of these scholarships unless the emoluments, scholarship or stipend are surrendered by him in favour of this scholarship.
- VII. The scholarship will be tenable for a period of 3 years from the date candidate concerned accepts the award subject to the condition that he/she should submit six monthly progress report through his/her Guide, Head of the Department and the Dean of the Faculty concerned failing which or if the progress is found unsatisfactory, his/her scholarship may be discontinued by the Vice-Chancellor.
- VIII. Leave with stipend not exceeding 30 days for each completed year may be granted on the recommendation of the Guide. During the first year or any uncompleted year leave may be granted on pro-rata basis.
- IX. The Department may assign teaching work (theory or practical) not exceeding 6 hours per week to scholar.
