

Quotation for dismantling Oxford EDS attached with Hitachi SEM located at Geology Department, Faculty of Science and relocation and recommissioning at the proposed Central Instrumentation centre , Faculty of Science.

Instrument should be safely dismantled, cables have to be replaced, along with setup of new power supply, enclosure, and mountings, as per scope mentioned and reinstalled. The instruments are expected to be fully functional after the necessary reinstallation as mentioned.

Rate should be (FOR to the site) i.e. inclusive of cost of labour and towards the complete scope of work. Institute will not be liable to any additional cost.

General terms and conditions

1. The tender documents are to be submitted in two parts as **Technical Bid (and Financial Bid by hard copy by post/ courier)**.
2. No change, addition, alteration in the tender is permitted. Amendments, if any, should be duly initialled, failing which the offers are liable to be rejected.
Unsigned Tenders will be rejected.
The technical offer **should not contain any price information.**
3. The vendor should produce certificate of experience for the **relocation and reinstallation of EDX attached with SEM.**
4. The vendor should submit copies of suitable documents in support of their reputation, credentials and past performance about such relocation of instruments in premier Institution(s). Without these documents the tender may be rejected by the Institute.
5. Interested vendors may visit the site to get an estimate of the work involved in the process of re-installation.
The quote should include the requirement for pre re-installation of the respective instruments.
6. Payment will be released after complete reinstallation of the respective instrument. No advance or part payment against the quoted amount will be made.
7. The vendor rates should be valid upto a minimum period of 90 days from the opening date of the quotation.
