NEP-2020 has been implemented in the university from the academic year 2023–24 as per directives from the GOG. In order to cater to the student life cycle (admission, exit, result process, progression to the next level), the following are the rules to be observed by the university:

1. This is resolved that the weightage of Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) - [Formative]: Semester End Evaluation (SEE) - [Summative] shall be as 50:50. (i.e. a Course having Total Marks as 100 will have 50 marks for IA and 50 marks for UA; whereas a course having Total Marks as 50 will have 25 marks for IA and 25 marks for UA.)
2. The Minimum Passing Marks shall be 36 for a course of 100 marks and 18 for a course of 50 marks.
3. The Examinations Pattern will be as follows:

Credits	MAX Marks	CCE (IA)	SEE (UA)	Duration of SEE

Note: Duration and methodology of CCE may be decided by the concerned Faculty/College as per NEP-2020 Regulations.

4. **All SEE must involve External Examiners from the respective Universities in the assessment process, contributing to 50% of evaluation.**
5. This will be mandatory for a student to appear for both assessment types, i.e. UA-Semester End Evaluation (SEE) - [Summative] and IA-Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) - [Formative].
If any student fails to appear at any of these assessment types, either UA or IA, his/her status of the result will be "Pass" BUT "Not Exempted".
In such case there will be TWO Scenarios:
A. IA=ABSENT => Such students who could not appear for IA Examinations [Due to any genuine reason(s)-to be documented and administratively approved by competent authority in this regard] be provided with an ADDITIONAL Chance to build his/her IA - Before the SEE-UA.



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After exhausting all possibilities to build IA for such a student, if he/she still fails to remain present and build his/her IA appropriately, then such a student **BE NOT ALLOWED TO APPEAR FOR THE CONCERNED UA-SEE COURSE/PAPER** by the respective Faculty/College. The status of the particular Course/Paper on the Statement of Grade would be "Not Eligible – NE" for IA-CCE as well as UA-SEE. A written communication with the reason statement **to the student** as well as **the University Examinations section** be initiated by the respective Dean of the Faculty/Principal of the College. Such students shall have to build his/her IA suitably in consultation with the respective Faculty/College, and to appear for concerned UA-SEE at the next examination under the Repeater category [If NE in some of the Course(s)/Paper(s)] or Never Appeared category [If NE against all Courses/Papers], as the case may be.

- B. The second scenario will be a student having IA, but fail to remain present at UA-SEE in one or all Courses/Papers of the concerned semester, then such student shall have to appear for his/her concerned Course(s)/Paper(s) as a "Repeater" student in the concerned UA-SEE at the ensuing backlog examinations.

These scenarios are explained in the below mentioned table:

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6. Progression to;

- the Second year (Level-5) from First Year (Level-4.5),
- the Third Year (Level-5.5) from Second Year (Level-5), and
- the Fourth Year (Level-6) from Third Year (Level-5.5)

Shall be allowed to those students only who have earned all credits, have the status as successfully completed for all the courses of their concerned immediate lower year (Both semesters) and does not have any backlog/deficiency for any preceding years. The Yearly result status should be "Completed or Pass" for all preceding years are only eligible to move upward as shown above.

7. Backlog examinations will be held twice a year, immediately following the declaration of Semester Evaluation Results. Consequent upon this implementation the scheme of Verification (Rechecking), Re-evaluation, Inspection of Answer-books will require to be withdrawn to meet the time-lines for the conduct of Backlog examination immediately after declaration of the results.

However, looking at the current situation related to the implementation of NEP -2020, for the time being at the Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda for the academic year 2023-24 the existing system of conducting of examinations shall continue with the scheme of the verification. Re-evaluation. Inspection of answer books instead of conducting of Backlog examination immediately after the declaration of the results.

Also for the academic year 2023-24 in CEE (IA) - Absent & Present in SEE (UA) their result for the particular examination event shall be kept as TDL (To be Declared Later).

8. Student who chooses to exit at any level have the option to re-enter to complete the same UG Degree from where he/she left off, he/she can re-enter any other HEI (or the same HEI) within THREE Years of his/her exit.

Any student must have to complete the Degree Programme within the stipulated maximum period of SEVEN Years from their initial admission year to the concerned UG Programme.



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9. Multiple Entry and Multiple UG Exit (MEME) scheme shall be applicable for the academic programme with the same Fee Category. i.e. any student admitted under the academic programme with "Regular Fee under GIA: shall be permitted through MEME scheme in any of the academic programme having programme with "Regular Fee under GIA", and those students admitted under the academic programme with "Higher Payment Fee – MSUHP" shall be permitted to move through MEME scheme in any of the academic programme having "Higher Payment Fee –MSUHP" only.

Lateral movement from Higher Payment Programme having "Higher payment FEE – MSUHP" to Grant-in-aid programme having "Regular fee under GIA" and vice versa (Reverse entry –exit) will not be allowed / permitted at The Maharaja Sayajirao University Baroda.
