#### 1. PREAMBLE

The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda (MSU) is recognized as one of the premier institutions of higher learning and research in the country. His Highness Maharaja Pratapsinhrao Gaekwad pursued the idea of establishing a University and on the recommendation of a committee, the Government of Baroda, decided to establish a Residential University at Baroda. The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda came into existence on April 30,1949 with English as its medium of instruction.

The University has been assigned 'A+' Grade by National Assessment and Accreditation Council with CGPA of 3.43 in the year 2022 and has secured 90th Rank under National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) in the year 2021. The university has one main and 6 satellite campuses, spread over 274.81 acres of land; it comprises of 111 Departments under the umbrella of 14 Faculties, 3 Constituent Colleges, several Institutes and Centers of specialized studies, wherein more than 47,000 students pursue higher studies under the care and supervision of more than 1200 highly qualified and experienced teaching staff.

The University has 16 Hostels, Health Centre, Sports Ground, Convocation Ground, Press and Stationery Unit, Guest House as well as other academic and administrative units spread across the campus. Besides, there are 9 Multipurpose Auditoriums, 8 well equipped Seminar Halls, 2 Open Air Theatres, an Amphitheatre, a Play Box, an Art Gallery, an Arboretum, a Botanical Garden, several lecture theatres and conference rooms. The Archaeological Museum in the campus has a collection of Harappan unicorn seals, holy relics of Lord Buddha, Toraman, terracotta Buddha images and other articles. The University has an Astronomical observatory set up in 1939 to promote the field of Science, which holds an 8-inch refractor telescope.

The University offers a wide range of academic programs from early childhood to Under-Graduate and Post-Graduate levels including Ph.D., with Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) for students to select value added subjects of their interest, other than Grant-in-Aid academic programs. The University also offers innovative Science and Technology programs in the field of Cell and Molecular Biology, Nanotechnology, Petroleum Geology, Medical Biotechnology, Bioinformatics, Disaster Management, Embedded Systems, Packaging Engineering, Welding Technology, etc. through some cutting edge research centres like Centre for Biotechnology, Prof. Bharat Chattoo Genome Research Centre, Centre for Molecular Genetics, Cluster Innovation Centre, Centre for Excellence in Polymer and Siemens Centre of Excellence for Industry Automation. Other than that, a number of socially relevant job and knowledge oriented academic programs are also on offer by the University like M.E. in Microprocessors & Robotics, Master of Urban and Regional Planning, Post-Graduate Diploma in Strategic Human Resource Management, P. G. Diploma in Food Service Management as well as Bachelor and Master of Design. University also offers Certificate Courses in Temple Management, Diet and Healthy Living, Sports Nutrition, Fitness Management, and many such other courses.

Aligning with the intent of the National Education Policy -2020, the university has revised all its UG programs, introduced two new UG programs on Hindu Studies, Defence and National Security Studies and a Five-year Integrated program in Social Work with Multiple Entry and Exit options.

The University has developed student digital life-cycle through its own information system -MSUIS. It has also adopted Online Admission Application System and every year it gets admission queries of nearly 70,000 students across the globe. The University introduced reforms in the examination system and all faculties have been brought under MSU Examination Portal (MEP) system. The University fees' collection and other record keeping systems being online are of great help to the students.

The University has started student facilitation centre from where students get all academic and research enquiries taken care at one place. The dedicated portal for students facilitation "E-Pramanpatra" has been developed by the University for online query shooting regarding the documents and students can get the soft copy of their certificates and other documents by applying through online portal. The Student's Facilitation Centre provides the information related to admissions, courses, application forms, generation of examination forms & hall tickets, results, counselling and queries related to students' life cycle in the University.

As part of its commitment towards the implementation of National Education Policy-2020, very recently the university took the lead in organising a Western Zone Vice Chancellors Conference on the Implementation of NEP-2020 with the support of Department of Education, Government of Gujarat where in Vice Chancellors and NEP program Coordinators from almost 125 universities from the state of Gujarat, Maharashtra, Goa and Diu- Dadra Nagar Haveli participated to discuss issues, challenges experienced and plan the future road map for the implementation of NEP-2020.

#### 2. ADMISSION PROCEDURES

From the Academic Year 2024-25, the admission to any courses after Higher Secondary School Certificate Examinations (12<sup>th</sup> Standard) [except Engineering Diploma, Pharmacy, MBA and courses which are administered by ACPC] shall be through Gujarat Common Admission Services (GCAS) by Education Department, Government of Gujarat. Accordingly, Admission shall be carried out in accordance with guidance received from the office of GCAS.

For the academic year 2024-2025, students can submit their admission applications online through the Gujarat Common Admission Service (GCAS) portal at https://gcas.gujgov.edu.in/.


The eligibility for admission to a particular program and details of Faculties and Colleges are available on the university website, students are informed to thoroughly study all these details before starting to submit an online application form for admission. The processing fee of Rs. 300 (non-refundable) shall have to be paid online only via Net Banking, Debit/Credit Cards, or UPI. Apart from online submission of the

application and online payment of fees, there is no other option available, which may please be noted.

In order to submit an online application form for admission, the student must have a mobile number and email ID. The student will get OTP in the mobile number as well as email during the registration process for admission. On successful submission of the correct OTP from mobile as well as email the student will get the application number and password which the student shall have to keep it with them till the completion of the entire admission process.

The Faculties of the University will function as Help Centres. In case of any difficulty in filling the online form during the admission process, the help centre may be contacted.

The University admits the student in the program either by merit or by entrance test. The admission process flow chart for the student is as follows:



### 3. Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) for Applying through GCAS

Q.1	Who has to register to GCAS portal?
Ans	GCAS portal serves as a platform for applying to have an admission in any of the state's 15 government universities and their affiliated college's programs. However, only students who apply for admission to university- college-programs through the GCAS portal will be considered for admission to the programs listed on the GCAS portal of the state's 15 government universities.
Q.2	Does a student get admitted to the university or college through GCAS portal?
Ans	A student can register on the GCAS portal and secure admission in the college program of their choice in accordance with the prevailing rules of the respective university/college.
Q.3	In how many languages is data/ information available on the GCAS portal?
Ans	GCAS Portal is a bi-lingual portal. The information is available in both English and Gujarati languages.
Q.4	Can a student apply for multiple courses/Program/University/College through one application?
Ans	A student can choose more than one program-college-university in a single application. But student can get admission to single program through one application.
Q.5	Will there be a common timeline for the procedures of registration to admission to different UG, PG and Ph.D. programs? What could be the procedure of the complete registration process for a student?
Ans	There will be separate schedule for the procedure from registration to admission for Graduation programs, Post-Graduation programs and Ph.D. The students have to fill their registration forms with academic details, choice of colleges they want to take an admission in, registration fees payment and final submission of the application as per the schedule applicable to the courses they are applying for. After the final submission of registration form, the students have to check provisional admission offer list, register their grievance, if any, and get them resolved, check final admission offer list, check admission offered by login in GCAS portal and confirm their admission after paying the fees along with the document verification at the college they want to seek an admission in.
Q.6	How many colleges a student can choose for any course on the GCAS Portal?
Ans	Presently, there is no limit on the choice of the number of colleges for any course on the GCAS portal.
Q.7	Can I change my email ID and/or mobile number used for registration on the GCAS Portal?
Ans	Students are recommended to be careful while filling in the Registration form. Email id and Mobile Number once used for registration must be retained with the students until the completion of the admission process as

	they are used for a correspondence related to admissions and hence after. It is a mandatory field, so fill it very carefully as they cannot be changed.
Q.8	What are the additional documents required for students who have passed Std. 12 from boards other than GSHEB?
Ans	A list of documents which a student needs to upload on GCAS portal while applying for a particular degree course (as applicable) is available on GCAS portal. The link is: https://gcas.gujgov.edu.in/Content/information-manual- for-ug-pg-phd-197
Q.9	Can I change the preferred list of colleges selected by me after the submission of the application on the GCAS Portal?
Ans	Yes. The student can update the details of his application by the last date of application if he wants even after the final submission of his application. But after every such update/edit/correction, it is mandatory to submit the application.
Q.10	Can I change the major subject of the course after submitting the application on the GCAS Portal?
Ans	The student can update the main/major subject of his/her course by the last date of application even after the final submission of the application. But after every such update/edit/correction, it is mandatory to submit the application.
Q.11	What if the result of my board is not declared before the last date of application on the GCAS Portal?
Ans	If any board has not declared its results during the first round of admission process on GCAS portal, the student may apply during the second round of admission process on GCAS portal which shall be conducting after the
Q.12	What if the server/site hangs during the application process on the last day, and I could not submit the final application?
Ans	All possible measures are taken during the development phase to avoid such a situation. However, such a problem may arise due to Internet issues or if a large number of students access the website simultaneously. The registration form has a "Save & Next" feature, which you may use if you are not able to complete the entire form in one session. You are recommended to click on the "Save" button on each page/session separately to save the information, and you may proceed with filling out the remaining online registration form after refreshing the link or logging into your account in another session. You are also recommended not to wait till the last day to complete or submit the online form.
Q.13	Is there any concession on registration fees for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwD applicants?
Ans	Registration fees apply to all students without concession. However, reserved category students may get concession in admission fees as per the rules and regulations of respective colleges/universities as per the Government of Gujarat norms.
Q.14	What is the process for cancellation of admission after getting admission to any college?

Ans	Applications that are not submitted after corrections until the final
