

26th June is observed as the International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking to strengthen action and cooperation to achieve the goal of an international society free of drug abuse. Supported each year by individuals, communities, and various organisations all over the world, this global observance aims to raise awareness of the major problem that illicit drugs represent to society. On account if this a multi faculty Webinar on "Awareness about Drug abuse and illicit trafficking" was initiated and organised by Dept. of Environmental

Studies, Faculty of Science, Maharaja Sayajirao University Baroda in collaboration with The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda Union, Faculty of Social Work, National Service Scheme, Faculty of Law & Faculty of Journalism and Communication on 28th June 2021. The programme was commenced by address of Prof. Haribhai Kataria, Dean Faculty of Science followed by opening remarks by Prof. Sunita Nambiyar, NSS. She introduced the theme for 2021 "Share Facts on drugs, Save Lives" and gave insights to recent statistics about the drug abuse. She highlighted "Peer Pressure" to be a major cause amongst youth suffering from drug abuse. She also pointed out the importance of "Red Flags" -sudden behavioural changes which promptly need to identified and followed by counselling. Shri Shailendra Kumar Mishra, Zonal Director, Ahmedabad, NCB, the first keynote speaker gave a stimulating speech to the participants elaborating about the types of drugs and pathways of illicit trafficking going across globe. He shed light on the fact that drug usage was not wrong but the overuse or abuse of the drugs trapped individuals to develop psychotropic symptoms and eventually lifelong dependency on drugs. He also highlighted that the age group 17-35 years was the most commonly targeted group in this area and youth is lured into drug abuse and later into illicit trafficking. She elaborated the laws related to drug abuse mentioned in the 7th Schedule, Article 47 of Constitution of India. She also talked about the initiatives by the government such as Electronic border surveillance, ISRO satellites to capture illegal trafficking and partnership with civil societies and NGOs for motivating youth to not to consume drugs or to trade in drugs. #### Judges: For Different languages were


- English poem competition- Dr. Shaurya Brahmbhatt
